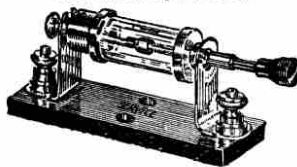

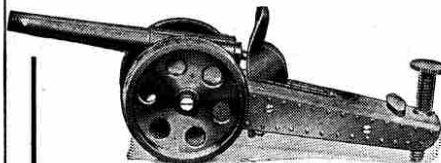

It is very necessary that a perfectly air-tight joint should be made, and the greatest care must also be taken to ensure that no stress is set up in the glass during the operation. So beautifully does the machine do its work, however, that notwithstanding these severe calls upon it, there are very few faulty stems to be rejected at the final inspection.

the year of issue. Thus, instead of having the control letter "C" (which was the one then in use), the figure "4" was added to indicate the year 1904, and the control thus became "C4." This was followed by "D4," "D5," and so on, the letter continuing to indicate the batch or order letter. Two controls with the same letter (as "D4" and "D5") mean that the "D" order was not completed in 1904 and that the remainder was printed in 1905, and so on.

Details of Controls

The numbering was re-commenced at "A" when the new printers took over in 1911, and again in the same year when the first Georgian stamps appeared. At the same time the system of control numbers was extended to all values up to one shilling, instead of being confined to the ½d. and 1d. values as previously.

During the present reign the stamp printing has been shared by the Board of Inland Revenue at Somerset House and

by two firms, Messrs. Harrison & Sons and Messrs. Waterlow & Sons. The stamps printed at Somerset House have control numbers in thin type and have a full-stop between the letter and number (Fig. 1). The Harrison stamps have thick letters and figures 5 mm. high (Fig. 2), while the Waterlow stamps have letters and figures 3 mm. high (Fig. 3). Advanced collectors include all these controls in their collections, often with three stamps attached to each control (as in Fig. 2). The stamp above the control itself is the essential stamp, of course, that on the left serving to show the position of the control on the bottom row, since it allows the corner margin to be retained. The stamp on the right is retained in order to make the whole more evenly balanced. This is the most expensive way of collecting controls—for it means that three stamps have to be paid for every time a new control is issued, which is about once a fortnight.

Some collectors collect controls without the stamp on the right, and some with only the one stamp above the control itself. Although this saves initial outlay the collection is by no means so valuable.

Glass cases and bottles displayed hundreds of beautiful shades of dyes, and I could not help wondering why people imagine they must send abroad for really satisfactory dyes.
